

## Day 6

This is a day when you will drive the most but also get to feast your eyes on the breath-taking scenery while visiting lovely Croatian towns and villages along the road. You take the **Adriatic Highway** a.k.a. “Jadranska magistrala”, which is one of the most beautiful and scenic roads in the world. Remember to drive safely! You make a short stop in **Rovinj**, which is one of the nicest and most popular Istrian towns. Treat yourself to some coffee and enjoy a pleasant walk through the town’s old streets, which can make up for some very photogenic scenes to capture your memories.

In the afternoon, you take the old road and continue towards **Zadar**. There are numerous unmarked stops en route that serve as excellent viewing points and photo stops. There is an excellent restaurant in Zadar - Rafaello, which serves delicious food and generous portions. After lunch, drive to the public parking lot “Parking Zadar” by the City Gate and take a stroll through town; only a few meters away from the parking lot you will see the Barkajol of Zadar - a special boat that has been connecting the main pier and Zadar City Walls since the 14th century. Time for a well-earned dinner and rest.
